He lives in Lebanon, Mississippi, and enjoys keeping up with basketball, and has fond memories of dancing.

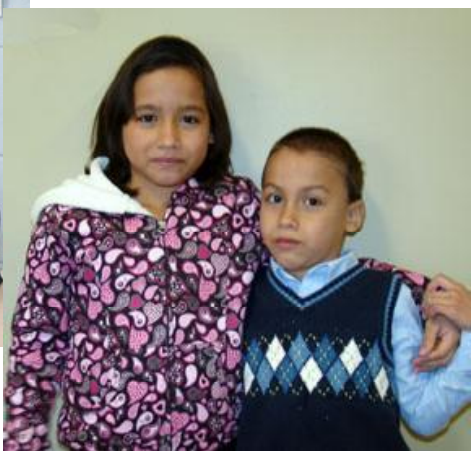
Mrs. Worrell surprised everyone with a visit to a recent basketball game in our gym.
